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## LIKOVNI / CHARACTERS

### Ismail / Ishmael



Mladi mornar koji želi da vidi sveta i nauči da lovi kitove. Svedok je borbe između kapetana Ahaba i velikog belog kita Moby Dika.

Young sailor who wants to see the world and find out about whaling. He witnesses the struggle between Captain Ahab and the great white whale Moby Dick.

### Kvikveg / Queequeg



Urođenik harpunar koji se sprijateljuje sa Ismailom i prati ga na istom kitolovcu. Smirene je naravi, veoma je mudar i velikodušan.

Native harpooner who befriends Ishmael and accompanies him on the same whaling ship. Of a tranquil nature, he possesses great wisdom and generosity.

### Kapetan Ahab / Captain Ahab

Iskusni kapetan kitolovačkog broda *Pikvod*; opsednut je da ulovi Moby Dika otkako mu je kit za vreme lova otkinuo nogu.



Experienced captain of the whaling ship *Pequod*; he has been obsessed with hunting down the whale ever since Moby Dick cut off his leg during a whale hunt.

### Prvi oficir Starbak / Chief Mate

#### Starbuck

Prvi oficir na *Pikvodu*; ozbiljan, mudar čovek. Ne razume kapetanovu opsesiju da goni i uhvati Moby Dika.



First officer on board the *Pequod*; a serious, prudent man. He does not understand his captain's obsession with pursuing and hunting Moby Dick.

### Drugi oficir Stab / Second Mate

#### Stubb



Drugi oficir *Pikvoda*. Uvek puši lulu i uvek je dobro raspoložen. Vrlo je iskusnan u lovu na kitove. Upravlja jednim od čamaca za kitolov.

The second officer of the *Pequod*. Always smoking his pipe and in a good mood. A very experienced man in whaling. He is in charge of one of the whaling boats.

### Tašteg / Tashtego



Indijanac harpunar koji je pomoćnik drugom oficiru Stabu na njegovom čamcu. On je jedan od onih koji sa *Pikvoda* osmatraju i traže kitove.

Red Indian harpooner who is assistant to Second Mate Stubb in his whaling boat. He is one of those who spot the whales from the *Pequod*.

### Fedala / Fedallah

Tajanstveni čovek koji prati kapetana Ahaba u njegovom pohodu da uhvati Moby Dika. Kapetan se u svom suludom poduhvatu vodi njegovim predviđanjima.



Mysterious man who accompanies Captain Ahab in his quest to catch Moby Dick. His predictions guide the captain in this mad enterprise.

### Moby Dik / Moby Dick

Veliki beli kit koji seje užas na moru. Prepoznatljiv je po svojoj blistavoj belini i svireposti kad napada. Star je kit i stoga vrlo pametan.



The great white whale, the terror of the seas. He is noted for his brilliant whiteness and his ferocity when he attacks. He is an old whale and thus very clever.

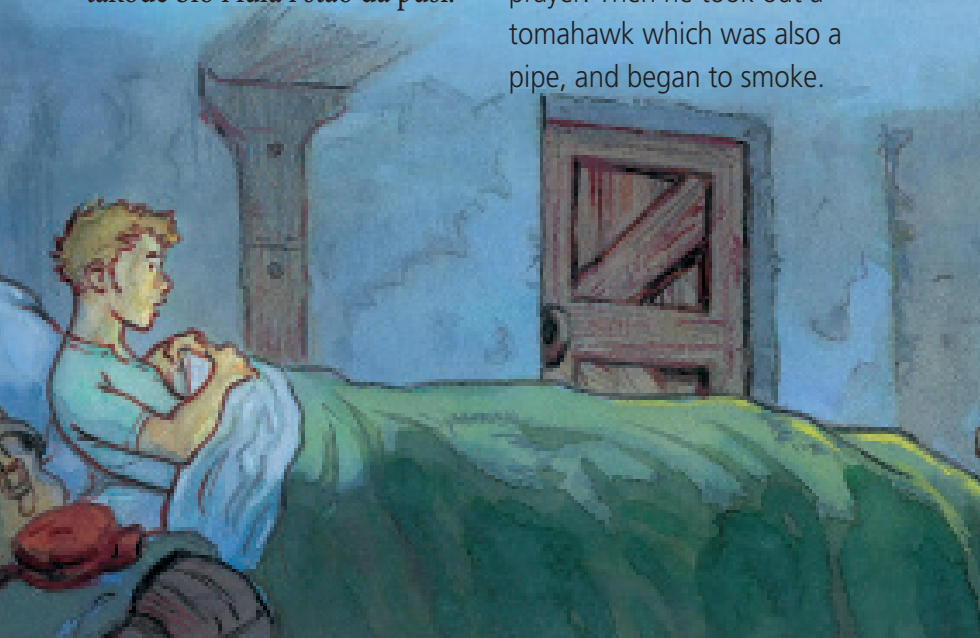
